## Information on School Supplies

We realize that the excitement and preparation for a new school year includes the purchase of various supplies for your student/s. Based on parent feedback and ongoing discussion with our team, for the 2020-21 SY Ledyard Public Schools will be making a slight modification to prior practice for "school supply lists."

We ask that ALL Students arrive on the first day with a plan for lunch (to purchase or bring their own) and a pencil/pen. Additional lists or requests are handled as follows:

**Elementary School Students** - Specific lists for classes and grade levels will be communicated by teachers no later than the first week of school. We will make every effort to provide supply lists around the same time as we post "class lists" for the new year.

**Ledyard Middle School** - A cover to protect the school issued Chromebook\*. Arrive for school with a pen, pencil and a notebook. Specific lists for classes will be communicated by individual teachers no later than the first week of school.

**Ledyard High School** - A cover to protect the school issued Chromebook\*. In general Ledyard High School allows students to make choices on their school supplies to support a student's individual organizational needs. At a minimum students will need a pen and a notebook on the first day. Should a course or teacher have a specific requirement that will be detailed in the course syllabus and/or communicated to the students during the first week of school.
